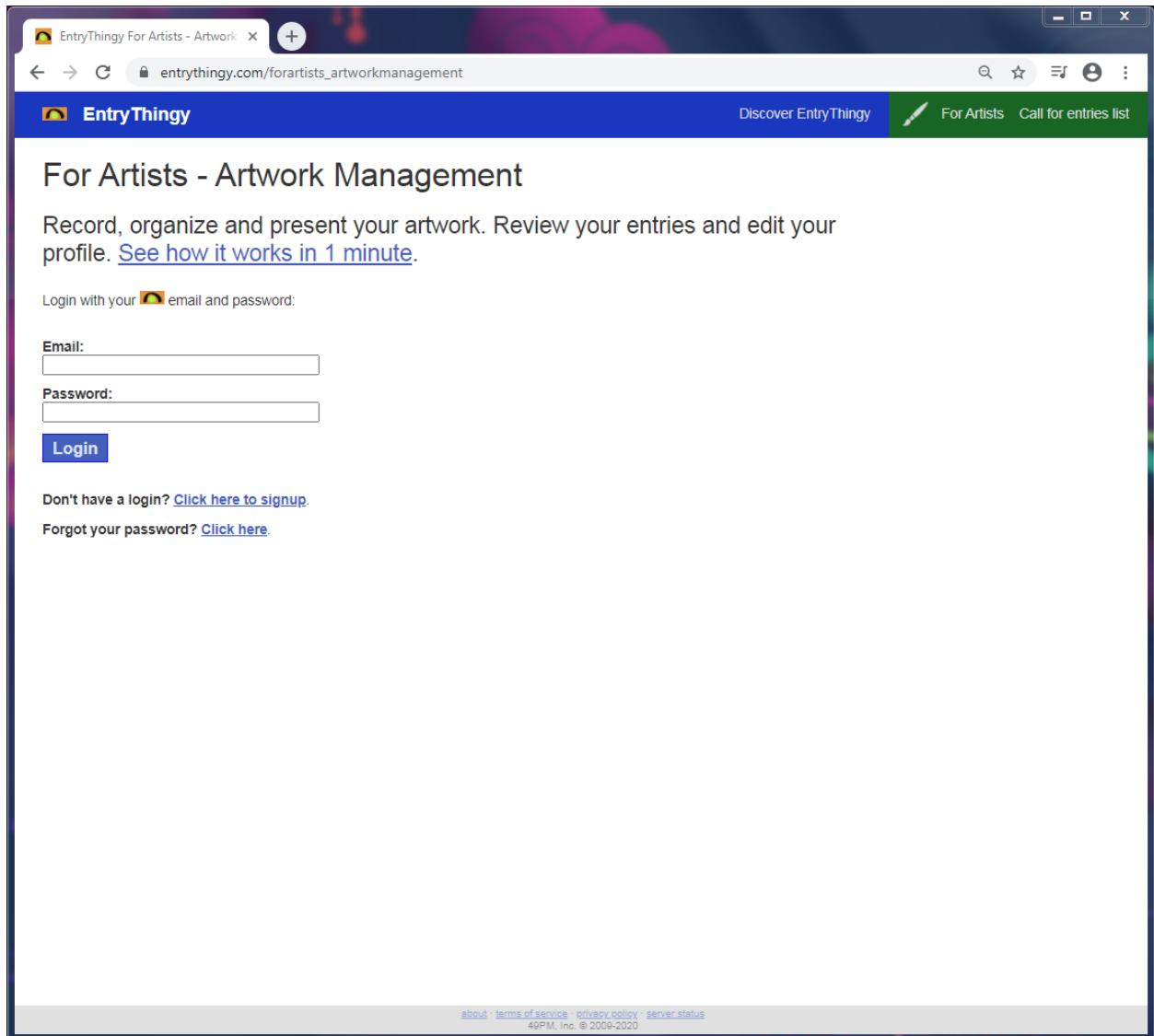

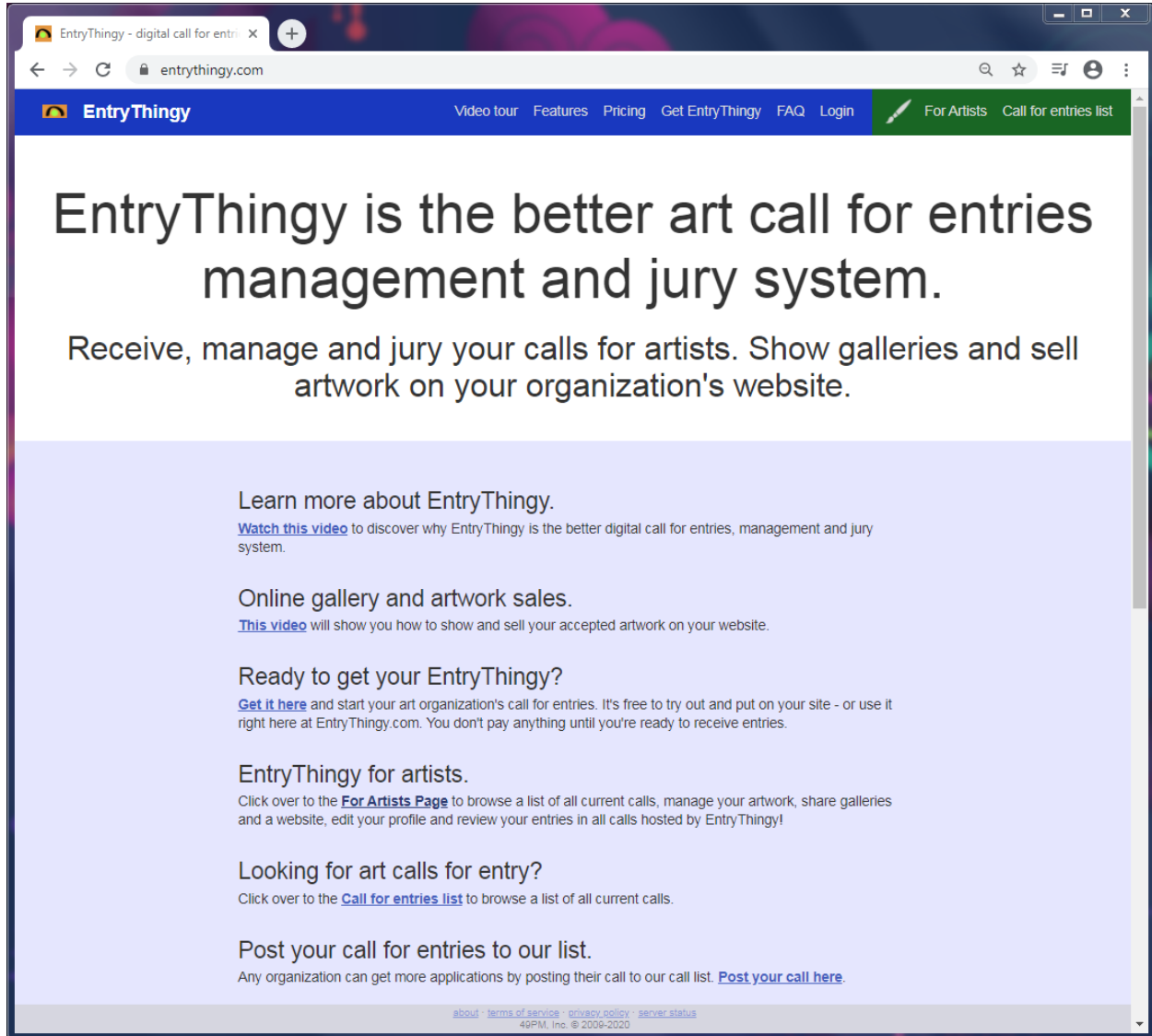

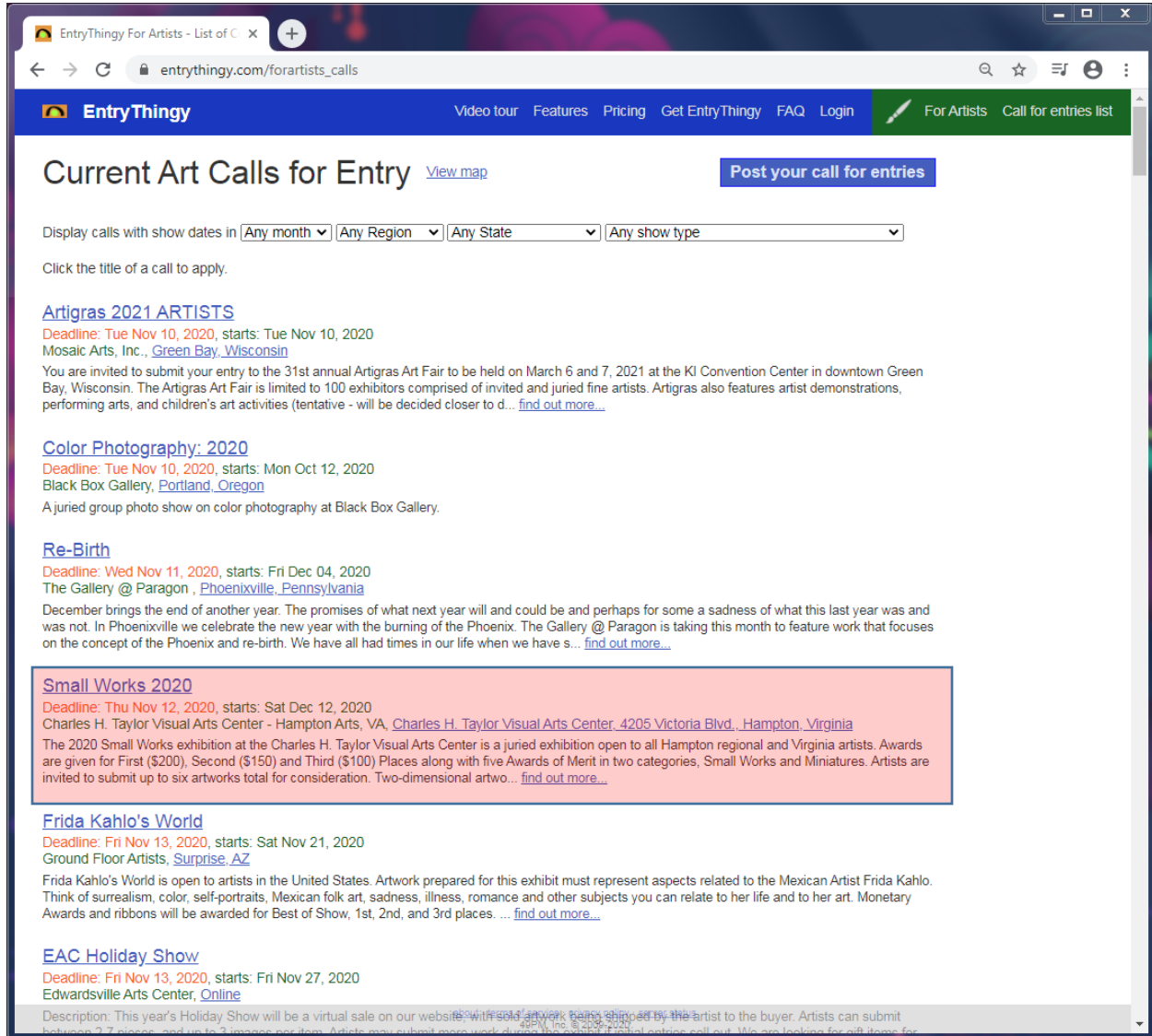
Step 2:

Small Works 2020
The 2020 Small Works exhibition at the Charles H. Taylor Visual Arts Center is a juried exhibition open to all Hampton regional and Virginia artists. Awards are given for First (\$200), Second (\$150) and Third (\$100) Places along with five Awards of Merit in two categories, Small Works and Miniatures.

Artists are invited to submit up to six artworks total for consideration. Two-dimensional artworks must be no larger than 8 x 10 inches (not including frame), and overall with framing no larger than 12 x 14 inches. Three-dimensional works must be no larger than 8 inches on any side. 2D artworks smaller than 20 square inches and 3D artworks smaller than 5 inches cubed are considered Miniatures. Open to all media. The entry fee is \$18 for up to six artworks.

The submission deadline is Thursday, November 12th at 5pm.
Because the exhibition runs through the holidays, artworks selected to be included in the exhibition that are for sale may be removed at the time of purchase during the exhibition.
Notification to artists will be sent by email by end of day November 19th.

2020 Small Works Size Guidelines -
2D Maximum artwork size is 8 x 10 inches (with framing not to exceed 12 x 14 inches)
3D Maximum artwork size not to exceed 8 inches on any side or diameter

Artwork delivery dates for accepted artworks are Sat, Nov 21 1-5pm; Tues-Wed, Nov 24 and 25 10am-5pm; and Tues, Dec 1 10am-5pm. Artists shipping their work must include or email a return shipping label for their artwork. The deadline for shipped work is also December 1st.

2020 Virginia Artists Juried Exhibition
2020 Virginia Artists Juried Exhibition. This exhibition competition awards \$3,900 in cash prizes and a solo exhibit for the Best in Show winner. Juror: Diana Blanchard Gross is Curator for the Peninsula Fine Arts Center in Newport News and has over 20 years of experience as a curator. Virginia artists (ages 18 and over) are invited to submit up to three original artworks for consideration. Only artworks created by the artist within the past two years and not previously shown at the Charles H. Taylor Visual Arts Center are eligible.

Artists Who Teach 2020
Artists Who Teach is a juried exhibition of Hampton's regional art educators. Awards will be given for the David J. Levinson Best in Show Award (\$1000), First (\$500), Second (\$250) and Third (\$100) Places. Artist and educator Clay McGlamory is this year's juror. McGlamory taught at Old Dominion University for 19 years and has been teaching at the Governor's School for the Arts for 28 years. He runs his own press, Half Ass Press, based in Norfolk, and is current President of the Virginia Glass Guild.

Entry Instructions

Thank you for entering your artworks to the Charles H. Taylor Visual Arts Center's Small Works exhibition in Hampton, VA. Please do not enter if you are not a Hampton regional or Virginia artist.

ONLY click the 'Submit Entry' button when you have finished entering ALL of the artworks you will be submitting for entry. Artists can submit up to six artworks for consideration. Please upload no more than two images per artwork submitted (a main image and one detail image). Images should be no smaller than 700kb and no larger than 10mb.

Artist submissions are not complete until we receive payment of your \$18 entry fee. After you enter and upload ALL your artworks, ONLY then click the 'Submit Entry' button. Then you will be able to pay with a credit card using the payment button where you will be taken to a secure Hampton Arts banking site.

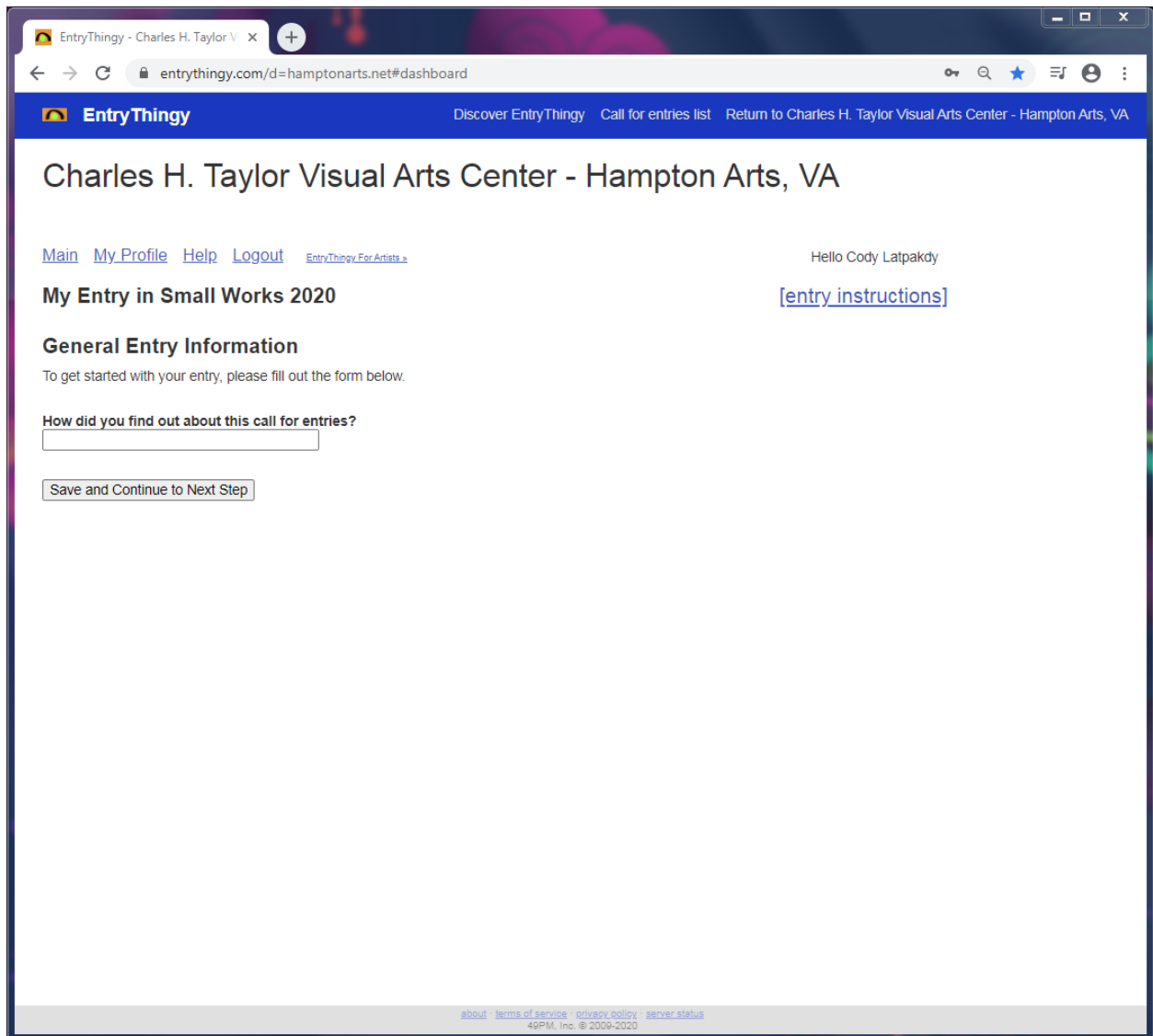

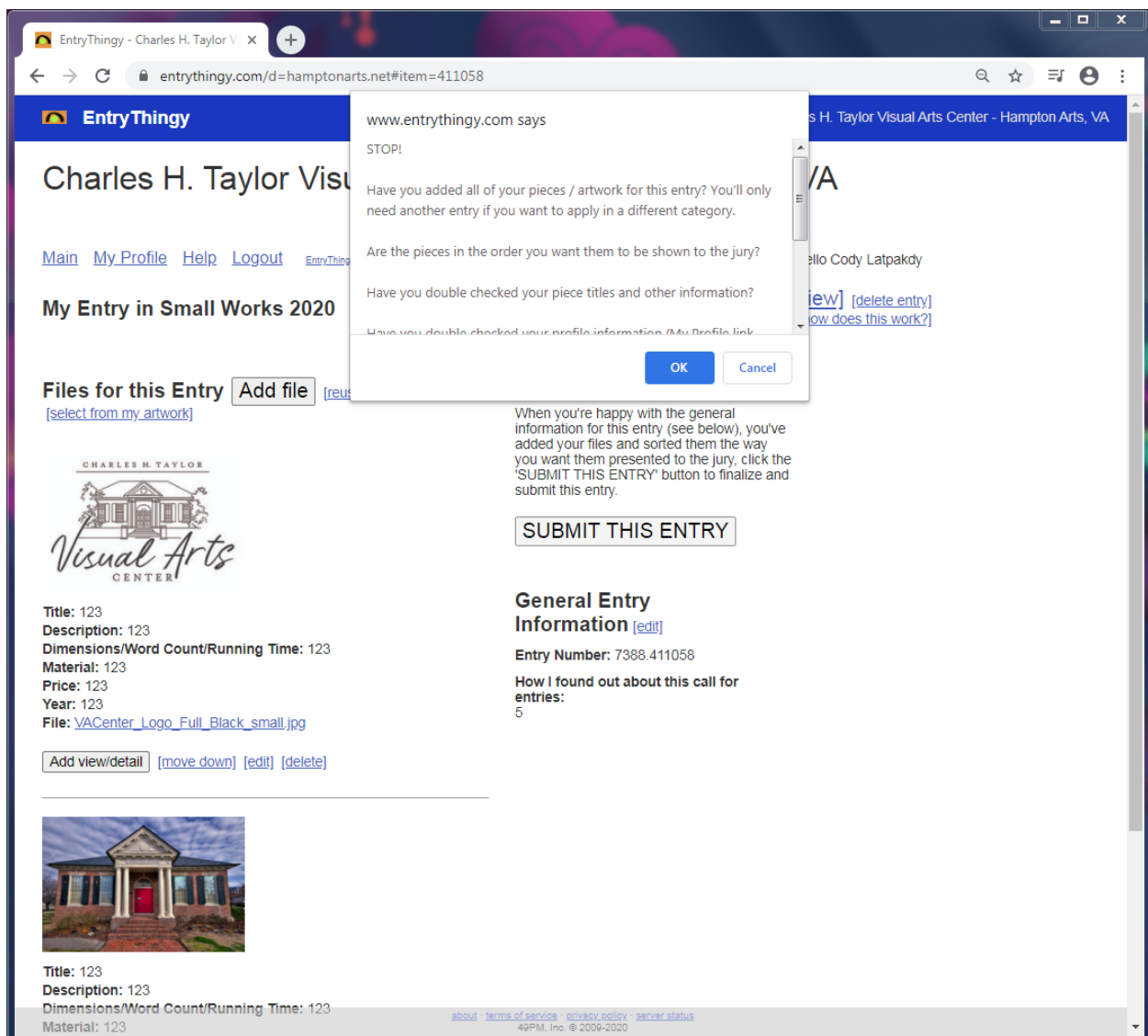

A message will pop up with a checklist to make sure you've gotten everything.

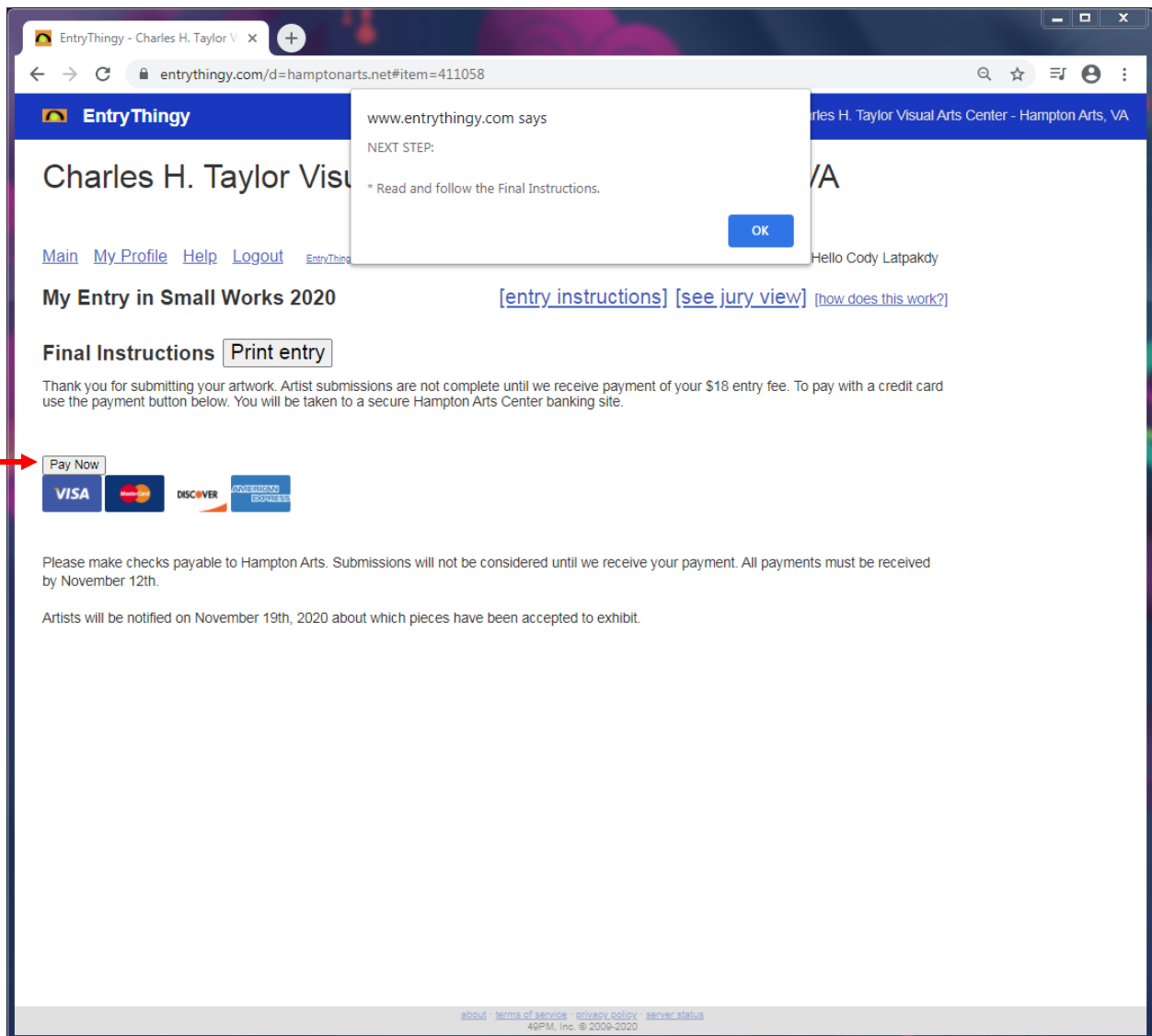
Hit "OK" when you know that all the information about your submission is there.
